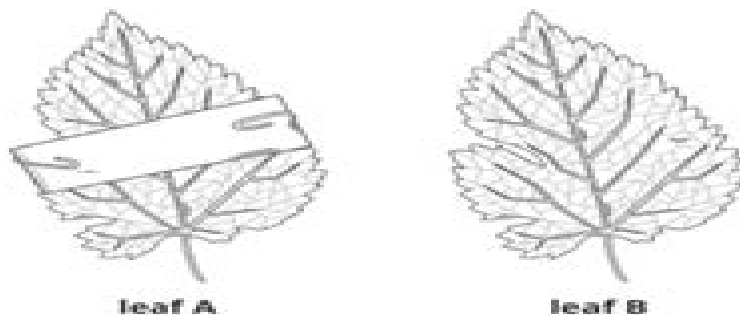

What is the source of this energy? **the sun**

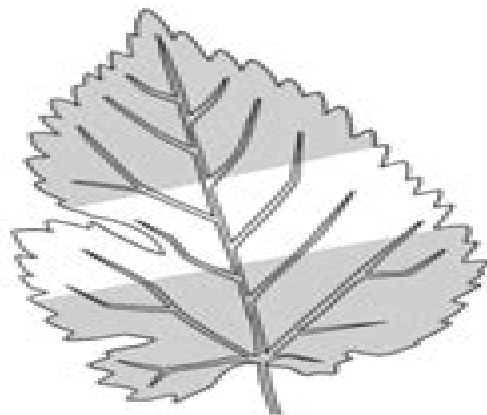

The card stops the light from getting to the leaf and therefore the leaf cannot photosynthesise. This means only the uncovered areas will contain starch and will therefore turn blue/black.
