oriented program with different trade offs Another unique feature of the book is that that new material is not used or referenced before it has been discussed The book is essentially incremental in nature so that new concepts being introduced always build on earlier concepts Thus readers are only exposed to new concepts or language features when pre requisite material has been completely discussed Also great care has been taken to avoid the use of programming language features which though very useful for advanced programmers can make it harder for a beginner to focus on and learn the object oriented principles being imparted This book is based on the experience gained from many years of teaching object oriented programming to beginners who know another programming language It is likely to benefit readers who are looking for a good practical introduction to object oriented programming in Java in an easy to understand format
