largely due to the fact that before such time the surname Franklin did not even exist The author explains in a quick primer the changing nature of the populace in Western Europe in this Renaissance cum Elizabethan era as commoners and peasants began to emerge from the veil of feudalism in England as the merchant class arose and as slowly merit began to surpass bloodline in dictating ones future This change would not come into fruition until the founding of the American state and is arguably a line of thinking that strongly informs much of the American identity to this day
