Academic writing in particular often poses a conflict of identity for students in higher education because the self which is inscribed in academic discourse feels alien to them. The main claim of this book is that writing is an act of identity in which people align themselves with socio culturally shaped subject positions and thereby play their part in reproducing or challenging dominant practices and discourses and the values beliefs and interests which they embody. The first part of the book reviews recent understandings of social identity of the discursal construction of identity of literacy and identity and of issues of identity in research on academic writing. Diagnostic Writing Assessment Ute Knoch, 2009. The diagnostic assessment of writing is an important aspect of language testing which has often been neglected in the literature. However it is an area which poses special challenges to practitioners both in the classroom and in large scale testing situations.
