Academic writing in particular often poses a conflict of identity for students in higher education because the self which is inscribed in academic discourse feels alien to them. The main claim of this book is that writing is an act of identity in which people align themselves with socio-culturally shaped subject positions and thereby play their part in reproducing or challenging dominant practices and discourses and the values, beliefs, and interests which they embody. The first part of the book reviews recent understandings of social identity, the discursive construction of identity, literacy, and identity, and of issues of identity in research on academic writing.
