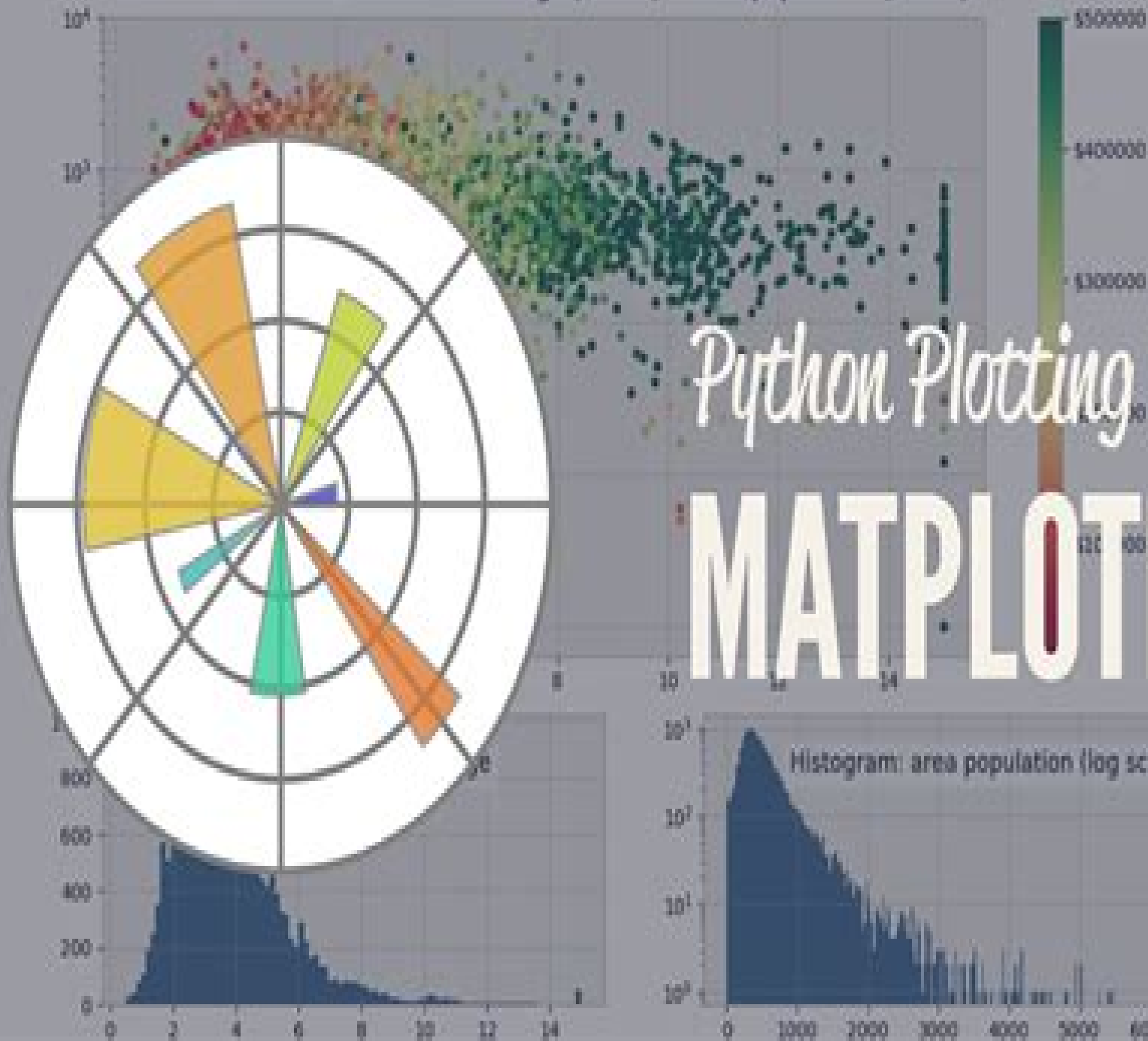


Home value as a function of home age (X-axis) & area population (Y-axis)
