Because individual phones lack considerable transmitting capacity, the system relies on a network of cellular towers able to triangulate any signal's source and delegate reception chores to the best available antenna

Data transfer through cellular networks is achievable with current 4G systems capable of speeds comparable to cable DSL

Cell phone carriers charge their consumers by the time for voice calls and by the kilobyte for data
