fantasize ourselves as better more important and better off than we really are Indulgence in such entertainment helps us avoid temporarily unpleasant truths that we must live with and it is this escape from unpleasant reality that gives us the terms escapist and escapism The notion of escapism evokes a whole chain of terms and concepts directly connected to it repression distraction travel leisure self discovery and of course places imagined or real to whom the individual wishes to escape to In this paper I want to analyze three books on escapism and the various ways in which it presents itself in them My focus will be on Alex Garland's backpacker cult novel *The Beach* and William Sutcliffe's debunking of the gap year traveler in *Are You Experienced* as well as Jon Krakauer's non fiction book *Into The Wild* The first two belong to backpacker fiction a genre that emerged particularly forcefully at the turn of the 21st century The authors of these narratives employ satire in order to debunk the escapism and self fashioning of a demographic of young urban Anglophone travelers who exert traveling mostly as a staged interest for other cultures while in truth they seek self fulfillment and self gratification
