

lpmove	This command is used to move a print job from one printer to another. You can specify the job number and destination printer.
lprm	This command is used to remove print jobs from the print queue.
lpcancel	Similar to lprm, this command cancels print jobs in the print queue.
lpc	This command is used to control the printer daemon and its configuration.
lpcoptions	This command is used to set printer options, such as the number of copies and paper size.
lpstat	This command shows the status of the printer and the print queue.
enable and disable	These commands enable and disable printers respectively.
