Virtual DOM PerformanceHandling the DOM manipulation this way can lead to increased performance Manipulating the DOM by hand tends to be inefficient and is hard to optimize By leaving the problem of DOM manipulation to a good implementation you can save a lot of time and effort React allows you to tune performance further by implementing hooks to adjust the way the virtual tree is updated Though this is often an optional step
