clauses with a BE auxiliary and a past participle The book also explores a more fundamental question about Latin syntax namely whether or not the language is configurational in the sense that a phrase structure grammar with higher order constituents such as verb phrases is needed to describe and analyse Latin word order patterns Four pieces of evidence are presented that suggest that Latin is indeed a fully configurational language despite its high degree of word order flexibility Specifically it is shown that there is ample evidence for the existence of a verb phrase constituent The book thus contributes to the ongoing debate regarding the status of configurationality as a language universal
