NON-PHARMACOLOGICAL THERAPY TO TREAT MUSCLE SPASMS/SPASTICITY

MUSCLE SPASMS- INVOLUNTARY CONTRACTIONS OF MUSCLE OR GROUP OF MUSCLES. TONIC (SINGLE PROLONGED CONTRACTION) OR CLONIC (MULTIPLE RAPIDLY REPEATING CONTRACTIONS)

SPASTICITY- MUSCLE GROUPS REMAIN IN STATE OF CONTRACTION, USUALLY FROM CNS DAMAGE. MUSCLES BECOME STIFF WITH INCREASED MUSCLE TONE.

- *SIGNS/SYMPTOMS= MILD → SEVERE PAIN; EXAGGERATED DEEP TENDON REFLEXES; MUSCLE SPASMS; SCISSORING (INVOLUNTARY CROSSED LEGS); FIXED JOINTS.*
