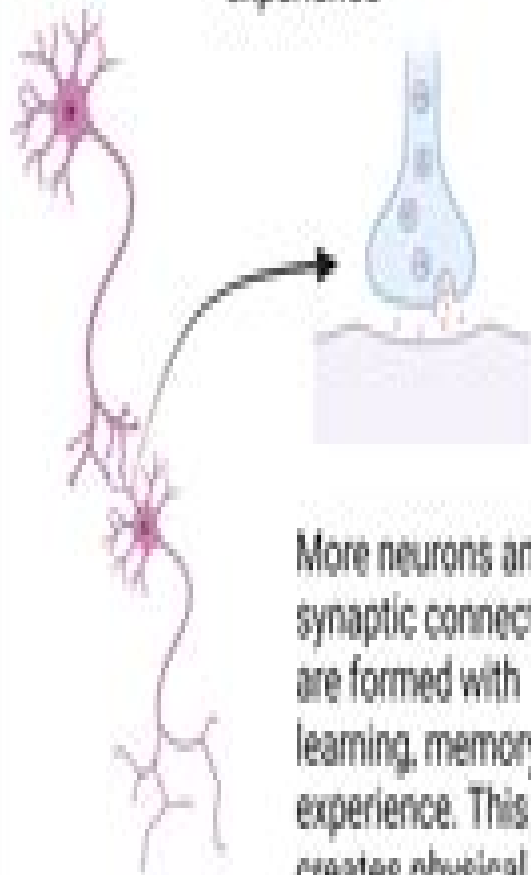


Structural Neuroplasticity
