Another unique feature of the book is that new material is not used or referenced before it has been discussed. Thus, readers are only exposed to new concepts or language features when prerequisite material has been completely discussed. Also, great care has been taken to avoid the use of programming language features which, though very useful for advanced programmers, can make it harder for a beginner to focus on and learn the object-oriented principles being imparted.
