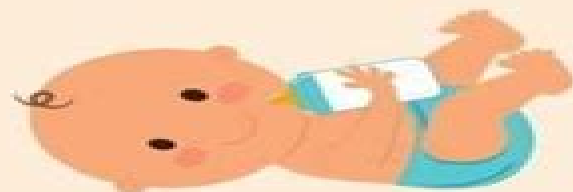


NEWBORN CARE BASICS 101: ESTABLISHING ROUTINE
