



# QUANTUM COHERENCE

Preserving coherence in quantum systems is crucial for quantum computing, communication, and sensing

**Coherence** is a measure of how well objects maintain their relationships with each other and how well the system's evolution can be predicted. The longer a system (represented mathematically as waves) remains coherent, the longer it has to process information. Coherence is fragile and hard to protect.

When a quantum object encounters environmental disturbances, the information stored in the coherent system is lost in a process called **decoherence**. Scientists are working to preserve coherence in quantum systems such as computers, networks, and sensors.
