A summary of regular & irregular verbs

VERB COMPONENTS

The Infinitive

The most basic form of the verb, such as *chanter* (to sing), *finir* (to end), *prendre* (to take), *voir* (to see)

- Verbs are composed of a stem or radical: The first portion of the verb, such as *chant-*, *fin-*, *prend-*.
- And infinitive ending: The last letters in the verb, such as *-er*, *-ir*, *-re*, *-oir*; the stem or radical and the ending create the verb: *chanter*, *finir*, *prendre*, *voir*, etc...

- Verbs are usually conjugated by removing the infinitive ending and applying a new ending, corresponding to a certain set of rules
- There are six different endings, one for each subject pronoun:
 - To use the verb *chanter* in the simple tense, take the stem *chant-* and attach the ending according to the following rules
 - For present tense:
 - Je: (first-person, singular subject pronoun) *chant+e*—I sing
 - Tu: (second-person, singular familiar subject pronoun) *chant+es*—you sing

- Il: (third-person, singular, male subject pronoun) *chant+e*—he sings
- Elle: (third-person, singular female subject pronoun) *chant+e*—she sings
- Nous: (first-person, plural, male and female subject pronoun) *chant+ons*—we sing
- Vous: (second-person, plural, male and female subject pronoun), and also: (second-person, singular, male and female, formal subject pronoun) *chant+ez*—you sing
- Ils: (third-person, plural, male subject pronoun) *chant+ent*—they sing
- Elles: (third-person, plural, female subject pronoun) *chant+ent*—they sing

REGULAR VERBS

1.-ER VERBS

- Verbs ending in *-er* are the most common; they follow the same conjugation as the verb *chanter*

Common -er verbs:

<i>chercher</i>	to look for
<i>danser</i>	to dance
<i>demande</i>	to ask
<i>donner</i>	to give
<i>fermer</i>	to close
<i>jouer</i>	to play
<i>laver</i>	to wash
<i>louer</i>	to rent
<i>marcher</i>	to walk
<i>montrer</i>	to show
<i>parler</i>	to speak
<i>refuser</i>	to refuse
<i>regarder</i>	to look at
<i>recevoir</i>	to meet
<i>rester</i>	to stay
<i>sauter</i>	to jump
<i>tomber</i>	to fall
<i>toucher</i>	to touch
<i>travailler</i>	to work

2.-IR VERBS

- With an infinitive ending in *-ir*, and also a present participle ending in *-issant*, they follow the same conjugation as the verb *finir*

Common -ir verbs:

<i>accomplir</i>	to accomplish
<i>choisir</i>	to choose
<i>envahir</i>	to invade
<i>finir</i>	to finish
<i>remplir</i>	to fill

3.-RE VERBS:

- With an infinitive ending in *-re*

Common -re verbs:

<i>attendre</i>	to wait for
<i>entendre</i>	to hear
<i>perdre</i>	to lose
<i>rendre</i>	to give back
<i>vendre</i>	to sell

- Verbs are conjugated to match pronouns in the following order:

- Je (I)
- tu (you, informal singular)
- il, elle (he, she, it)
- nous (we)
- vous (you, plural or formal singular)
- ils, elles (they)

SIMPLE TENSES

chanter (to sing), *finir* (to finish)

Present (le présent)

1. Regular -er verbs

<i>chant+e</i>	<i>chant+ons</i>
<i>chant+es</i>	<i>chant+ez</i>
<i>chant+e</i>	<i>chant+ent</i>

Ex: Elle *chantait* bien. (She sings well.)

2. Regular -ir verbs

<i>fin+is</i>	<i>fin+issons</i>
<i>fin+is</i>	<i>fin+issez</i>
<i>fin+it</i>	<i>fin+issent</i>

Ex: Ils *finissent* le livre.
(They finish the book.)

Imperfect (l'imparfait)

1. Regular -er verbs

<i>chant+ais</i>	<i>chant+ions</i>
<i>chant+ais</i>	<i>chant+iez</i>
<i>chant+ait</i>	<i>chant+aient</i>

Ex: Elle *chantait* bien. (She sang well.)

2. Regular -ir verbs

<i>fin+issais</i>	<i>fin+issions</i>
<i>fin+issais</i>	<i>fin+issiez</i>
<i>fin+issait</i>	<i>fin+issaient</i>

Ex: Ils *finissaient* le livre.
(They finished the book.)

Simple Past— literary tense

(le passé simple)

1. Regular -er verbs

<i>chant+ai</i>	<i>chant+âmes</i>
<i>chant+as</i>	<i>chant+âtes</i>
<i>chant+a</i>	<i>chant+èrent</i>

Ex: Elle *chantait* bien. (She sang well.)

2. Regular -ir verbs

<i>fin+is</i>	<i>fin+îmes</i>
<i>fin+is</i>	<i>fin+îtes</i>
<i>fin+it</i>	<i>fin+irent</i>

Ex: Ils *finirent* le livre. (They finished the book.)

Future (le futur)

1. Regular -er verbs

<i>chanter+ai</i>	<i>chanter+ons</i>
<i>chanter+as</i>	<i>chanter+ez</i>
<i>chanter+a</i>	<i>chanter+ont</i>

Ex: Elle *chantera* bien. (She will sing well.)

2. Regular -ir verbs

<i>finir+ai</i>	<i>finir+ons</i>
<i>finir+as</i>	<i>finir+ez</i>
<i>finir+a</i>	<i>finir+ont</i>

Ex: Ils *finiront* le livre.
(They will finish the book.)

Conditional (le conditionnel présent)

1. Regular -er verbs

<i>chant+erais</i>	<i>chant+erions</i>
<i>chant+erais</i>	<i>chant+eriez</i>
<i>chant+erait</i>	<i>chant+eraient</i>

Ex: Elle *chanterait* bien. (She would sing well.)

2. Regular -ir verbs

<i>finir+ais</i>	<i>finir+ions</i>
<i>finir+ais</i>	<i>finir+iez</i>
<i>finir+ait</i>	<i>finir+aient</i>

Ex: Ils *finiraient* le livre.
(They would finish the book.)

Present Subjunctive

(le présent du subjonctif)

- Follows expressions of attitudes, opinion, doubts, feelings and is introduced by *QUE*

- The subjunctive is used after:

- Verbs of wishing, desire, or will, such as:

<i>souhaiter que...</i>	to love that...
<i>désirer que...</i>	to desire that...
<i>souhaiter que...</i>	to wish that...

Ex: Je *souhaite* que tu *finisses* le livre.
(I wish that you finish the book.)

- Expressions of emotion, opinion, doubt, such as:

<i>être heureux que...</i>	to be happy that...
<i>être triste que...</i>	to be sad that...
<i>être surpris que...</i>	to be surprised that...
<i>avoir peur que...</i>	to be afraid that...

Ex: Nous *sommes surpris* qu'elle *chante* bien.
(We are surprised that she sings well.)

- Expressions of necessity and obligation, such as:

<i>il faut que...</i>	must
<i>il est essentiel que...</i>	it is essential that...
<i>il est nécessaire que...</i>	it is necessary that...

Ex: *Il faut* que nous *finissions* le livre.
(We must finish the book.)

1. Regular -er verbs

<i>chant+e</i>	<i>chant+ions</i>
<i>chant+es</i>	<i>chant+iez</i>
<i>chant+e</i>	<i>chant+ent</i>

Ex: *Il faut* qu'elle *chante* bien.
(She must sing well.)

2. Regular -ir verbs

<i>fin+isse</i>	<i>fin+issions</i>
<i>fin+isses</i>	<i>fin+issiez</i>
<i>fin+isse</i>	<i>fin+issent</i>

Ex: Je *souhaite* qu'ils *finissent* le livre.

(I wish that they would finish the book.)
