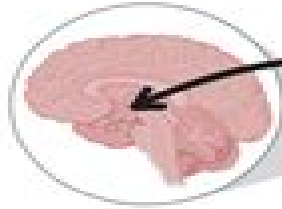

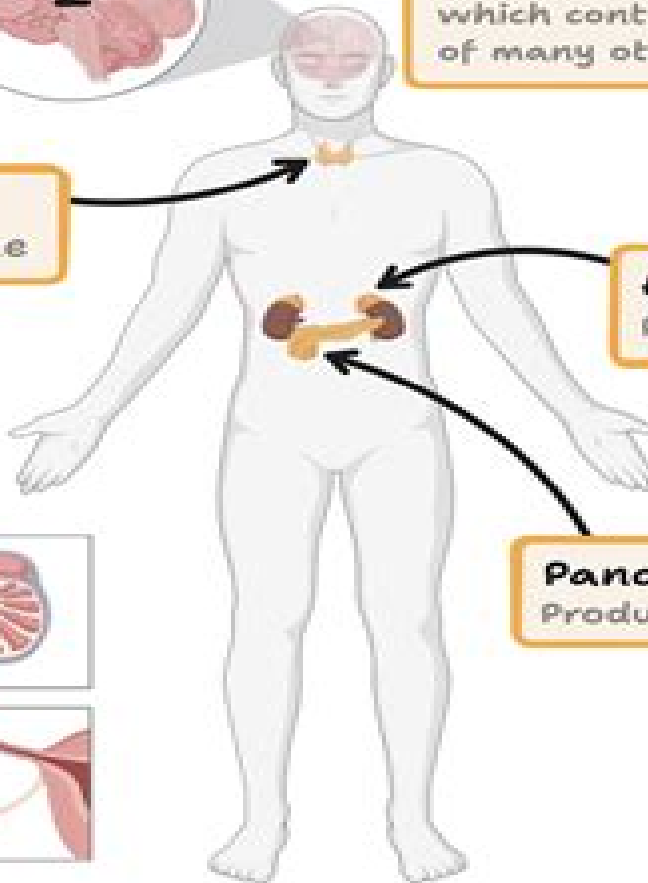


## Pituitary Gland:
