It is assumed that you already have experience with data manipulation language (DML) statements and know the basics of the mainstream SQL Server objects: views, stored procedures, user defined functions, etc. If you would like to brush up on your knowledge before diving into this book, the author recommends reading *Beginning SQL Server 2008 Programming* first. There is very little overlap between the *Beginning* and *Professional* books, and they are designed to work as a pair.
