The Invisible Hand Charlie Tims, Shelagh Wright, 2013-04-01 The economic crisis has squeezed the cultural sector across the world. But cut backs, closed theatres and moth-balled arts centres are only half of the story. When critics and historians look back to our times they'll be less preoccupied with the art that wasn't made and more with the art that was. Art that could explain how we arrived here, art that could do something about it, and art that showed the possibility of different ways of living.
