For this problem we want the voltage drop across the resistor R_s to be $0.01 \times V_s$. The current in the loop is $I = V_s / (R_s + R_i)$ and the voltage drop across the resistor is $V_{drop} = I \times R_s$.

Combining these:

$$0.01 \times V_s = V_s / (R_s + R_i) \times R_s = V_s / (120 + R_i) 120. \text{ Solving for } R_s, \text{ we get}$$

$$R_s = 11,880 \Omega.$$

3.5 The circuit resembles Fig. 3.9(a). The input voltage, V_i , is $I \times R_s$. The current is $V_s / (R_s + R_i)$. Combining, $V_i = R_s \times V_s / (R_s + R_i)$. In the first case:

$$0.005 = 5 \times 10^6 \times V_s / (R_s + 5 \times 10^6) \text{ For the second case:}$$

$$0.0048 = 10,000 \times V_s / (R_s + 10,000) \text{ These can be solved simultaneously to give}$$

$$R_s = 416 \Omega.$$
