

. Routine Data Quality Assessment (RDQA)

The Routine Data Quality Assessment (RDQA) Tool is a simplified version of the D Quality Audit (DQA) which allows programs and projects to verify and assess the quality of their reported data. It also aims to strengthen their data management and reporting systems.

The objectives and uses of the RDQA tool are listed in Table 8.1 and Table 8.2, respectively.

TABLE 8.1. Objectives of RDQA

Verify Rapidly

1) the quality of reported data for key indicators at selected sites, and 2) the ability of data management systems to collect, manage and report quality data.

Implement

corrective measures with action plans for strengthening the data management and reporting system and improving data quality.

Monitor

capacity improvements and performance of the data management and reporting system to produce quality data.
