

ELEMENTS OF CLINICAL EPIDEMIOLOGY

- In most clinical situations the diagnosis, prognosis, and results of treatment are uncertain for individual patients and, therefore, must be expressed as probabilities.
- Probability for an individual patient is best estimated by referring to past experience with groups of similar patients.
- Because clinical observations are made on people who are free to do as they please and by clinicians with variable skills and biases, the observations may be affected by systematic errors that can cause misleading conclusions.
- All observations, including clinical ones, are also influenced by the play of chance.
- To avoid being misled, clinicians should rely on observations that are based on sound scientific principles, including ways to reduce bias and estimate the role of chance.
