



Use the graphs to answer the questions.


- 1) The graph shows the temperature of an oven as it warms up.

- The graph is an example of logarithmic growth. Describe logarithmic growth in your own words.




- 2) The graph shows the average weight of a new born baby between 0 to 24 months.
