<code>lp</code>	Using this command, print jobs will be sent to the print options can be specified, such as the number of copies and pages.
<code>lpq</code>	This command displays the print queue, showing the waiting to be printed.
<code>lpr</code>	This command is used to print files directly from the command line. You can specify options such as the printer name and the number of copies.
<code>lprm</code>	This command is used to remove print jobs from the print queue. You can specify a job number or use the <code>-</code> option to remove all jobs.
<code>lpadmin</code>	This command is used to manage printers and print queues. You can use it to add or remove printers, change printer settings, and manage print jobs.
<code>lpinfo</code>	This command displays information about available printers, including their names, descriptions, and capabilities.
<code>lpmove</code>	This command is used to move a print job from one printer to another. You can specify the job number and destination printer.
<code>lprm</code>	This command is used to remove print jobs from the print queue.
<code>cancel</code>	Similar to <code>lprm</code> , this command cancels print jobs in the print queue.
<code>lpc</code>	This command is used to control the printer daemon and its configuration.
<code>lpcoptions</code>	This command is used to set printer options, such as the number of copies and paper size.
<code>lpstat</code>	This command shows the status of the printer and the print queue.
<code>enableprinter</code> and <code>disableprinter</code>	These commands enable and disable printers respectively.


