The second part focuses on ethical challenges students may face in clinical experiences or research. Topics such as working with indigenous communities, the politics of global health governance, and the ethical challenges of advocacy are explored using a case study approach. An Introduction to Global Health Ethics includes recommended resources and further readings and is ideal for students from a range of disciplines including public health, medicine, nursing, law, and development studies who are undertaking undergraduate and graduate courses in ethics or placements overseas.
