Max Frisch 1911-91 was one of the giants of twentieth century literature achieving fame as a novelist playwright diarist and essayist He received the Georg Büchner prize in 1958 and the Neustadt Literature prize in 1986 For many years a lecturer in German with a special interest in Austrian literature Mike Mitchell has worked as a literary translator since 1995
