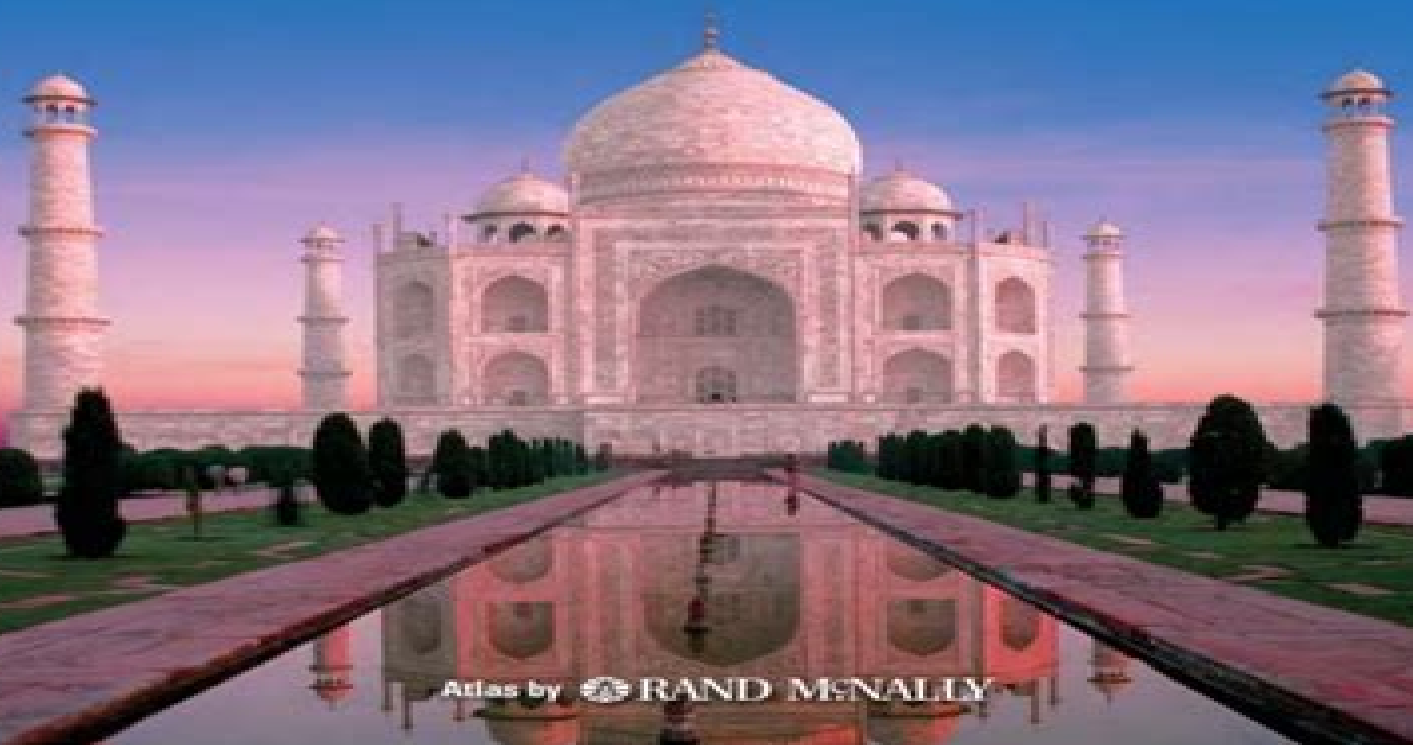
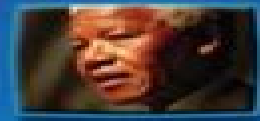

that borderland geographical space in which four of the world's greatest civilizations have overlapped in a sustained and meaningful way to produce a complex dynamic sometimes combustible multi-layered local civilization. It is the space in which the cultures of ancient Greece and Rome of Byzantium of Ottoman Turkey and of Roman Catholic Europe met, clashed and sometimes combined. The history of the Balkans can be seen as a history of creative borrowing by local people of the various civilizations that have nominally conquered the region.
