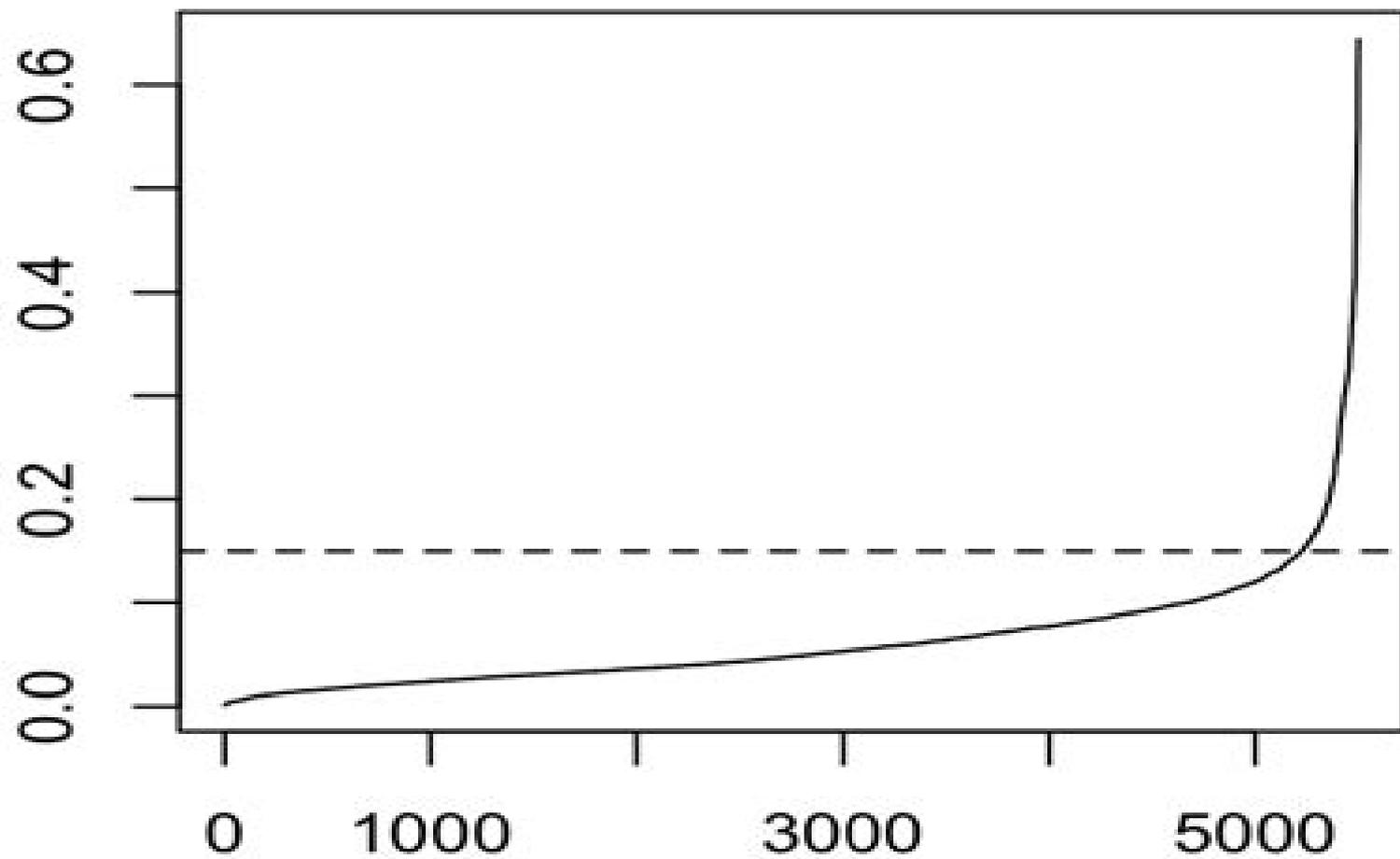

operation it outperforms KD In our experiments it takes KD 268 62 seconds to complete the clustering process while it takes KDS 237 836 seconds in the worst case
