The Architecture of Ruins Designs on the Past Present and Future identifies an alternative and significant history of architecture from the sixteenth century to the twenty first century in which a building is designed occupied and imagined as a ruin This design practice conceives a monument and a ruin as creative interdependent and simultaneous themes within a single building dialectic addressing temporal and environmental questions in poetic psychological and practical terms and stimulating questions of personal and national identity nature and culture weather and climate permanence and impermanence and life and death Conceiving a building as
