Nomenclature Rules

Function and variable names can consist of any alphanumeric character (0-9) and are allowed. The first character cannot be numeric. Many standard ASCII characters are allowed. There is no practical limit on name length. Names are case-sensitive.

If two or more variables or functions or a variable & a function are declared with the same name, the last declaration overrides all previous ones. Using a keyword as a variable or function name obliterates that keyword.

Visibility & Scope

Assignments without the use of the var keyword result in a new global variable of that name being created.

Variables declared with the var keyword outside the body of a function are global. Variables declared with the var keyword inside the body of a function are local to that function. Local variables are visible to all nested functions.

Local entities hide globals bearing the same name.

Special Values

The special values false, infinity, NaN, null, true & undefined are recognized. null is an object. Infinity and NaN are numbers.
